More than one million newborns don't survive their day of birth.

Hundreds of thousands of health facilities lack reliable electricity. The consequences are tragic. Health workers struggle in near-darkness, relying on inadequate light from kerosene lanterns, candles or cell phones. Critical procedures are delayed or cancelled. Lives are lost.

Our Technology

- The Solar Suitcase provides sustainable energy for medical lighting, fetal monitoring, and power for phone charging and medical devices. This enables health workers to provide timely, effective obstetric care.
- When health workers have access to electricity, they are more confident, safe, effective, and empowered to provide around-the-clock care.

Our Approach

- We partner with government ministries, UN agencies, and local and international NGOs in both the health and energy sectors to ensure our technology reaches rural health centers.
- Our technical workshops build local capacity in solar installation and maintenance to ensure program sustainability. Our gender-inclusive trainings promote women as trainers and solar installers.
- Our health worker trainings ensure that recipients know how to properly use the Solar Suitcase and related medical devices.

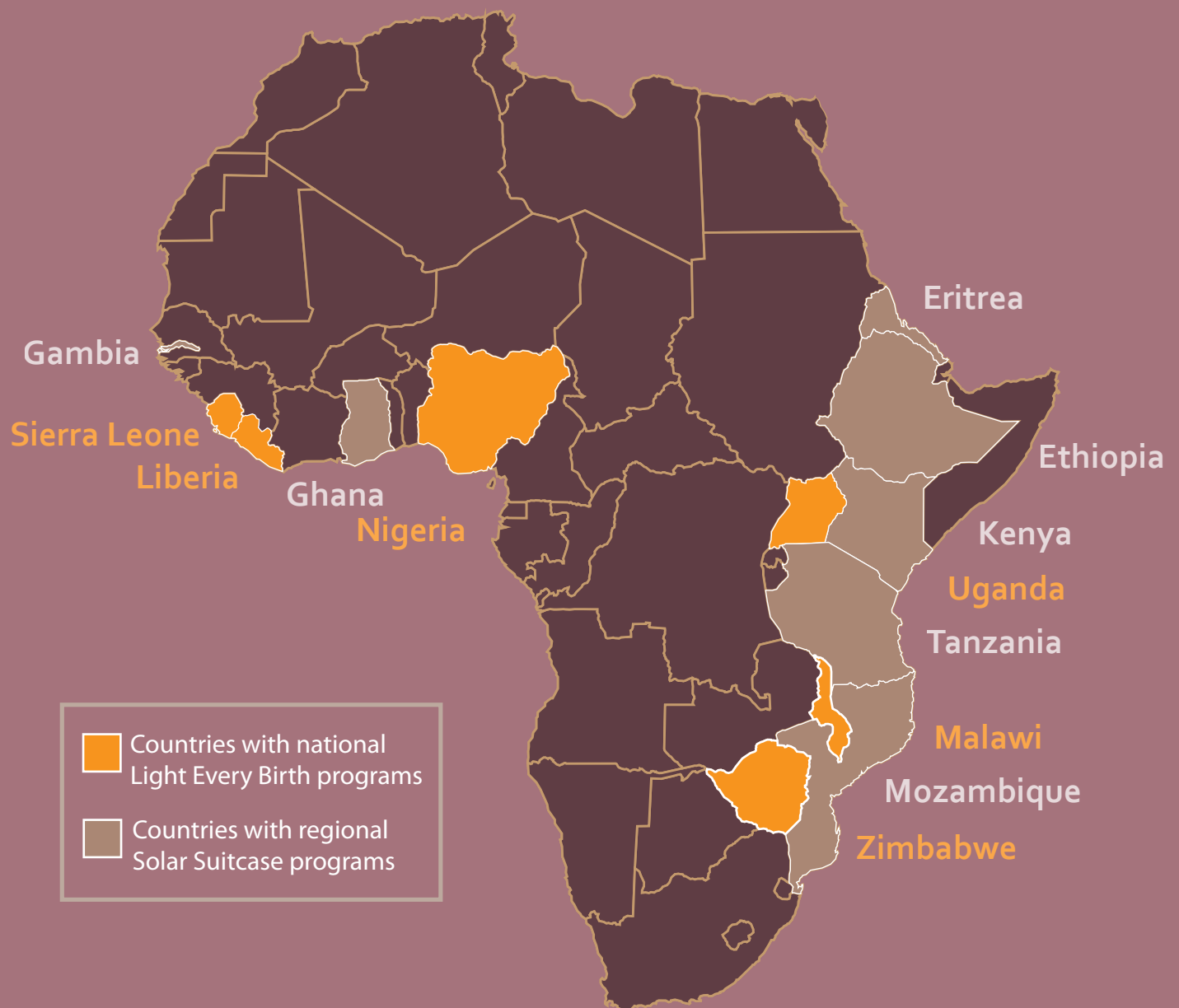

We are working country by country in partnership with government agencies and international NGOs to ensure that EVERY public maternal health center has reliable power for safe deliveries.

- Liberia: Achieved full country coverage in 2019
- Zimbabwe: Achieved full country coverage in 2021
- Sierra Leone and Uganda: Completing both countries in 2023
- Nigeria: Launched in 2022
- Malawi: Launching in 2023

We continue to expand our coverage to new facilities and countries each year.
